Each community should have a Community Emergency Response Team (CERT) made up of volunteers that have been trained in disaster response (first aid, fire suppression, and light search and rescue). Fill out your Pre & Post Disaster Forms. (BE Ready)

one person responsible for Rapid Impact Assessment and one Communication officer. (**NANCY LONG 2361 SW 18TH AVENUE CELL 954-294-8488**)

- These individuals need to meet with their City Fire Station Captain to set up how they will communicate together in the event of a disaster.
- The City's CERT teams act as an umbrella organization for the neighborhood. Vital information and bulletins are given to the station captains who pass these announcements on to each neighborhood Communicate Officer. Likewise, important information such as impact assessment is sent to the city via the station captains.

Before Hurricane Season

- Inform your neighborhood about the disaster plan and pre-select a location where your neighborhood will meet after a disaster/ hurricane. For **RIVER OAKS CIVIC ASSOCIATION**, it is **CHURCH OF THE NAZARENE (Day Spring international) located at 2300 SW 15th Avenue Fort Lauderdale Fl. 33315**
- Identify the frail and elderly (this needs to be done ASAP).

Upon Hurricane Warning or Declaration of Disaster

- Have your neighborhood Communication Officer Nancy Long will contact our city CERT captain.
- Your Cert station Captain will set a time for you to call after the storm.
- Set time and place your neighborhood is to meet right after the storm and inform the neighborhood. (**3 Hours after the all clear is announced meet at is CHURCH OF THE NAZARENE (Day Spring international) located at 2300 SW 15th Avenue Fort Lauderdale Fl. 33315**)

During Storm - Stay indoors!

After the Storm

- Give immediate help to your family, neighbors, then community.
- Our neighborhood Rapid Impact Assessment Team will take information on the following:
 - Building structural damage
 - Flooding/Roadway obstructions, individuals trapped
 - Utility status (water electric, gas lines, phones/cell service)
 - Emergencies
- Communicate to CERT station captain results of the above.
- Neighborhood receive update from their CERT station captain
- Initial Neighborhood meeting is **our Civic Meeting June 17, 2021** to review and organize our neighborhood post-storm needs.

We will be using emails, text messages, Next Door, and www.riveroakscivicassociation.com to reach as many of our neighbors as possible, with as much information before and after a hurricane. Please help your neighbors!

Supply list that you will need Pre-Disaster.

Please take the time now to gather any supplies that you may need in an emergency.

water soap flashlight toothbrush/razors
 food tarp/sheeting infant formula plywood
 baby bottles baby food diapers sanitary napkins
 toilet paper batteries hammer/nails plates/cups
 bleach duct tape matches manual can opener
 screwdriver/screws pliers/wrench pet food coolers/ice
 radio (batteries) first aid supplies knife/scissors medicines
 plastic garbage bags clothes, towels, blankets, pillow, sleeping bag
 Animal Supplies. propane or charcoal for grill

Fill your bathtub with water, any buckets, or containers to be filled with water.

BE sure to pack changes of clothes, and all your identification and valuable papers in waterproof bags. (In case of evacuation) you can easily grab and go.
